Intake forms can now be viewed, edited and signed in the same way as all other default and custom forms.</p> <p>Benefit: More efficient workflow and navigation through all remaining Intake forms (for example using "Save & Next" button), availability on iPad with consistent UI experience.</p>

ISSUE	DESCRIPTION OF THE ENHANCEMENT
MM-2656	<p>Medications - No sig showing in grid. Now physician can express sig (i.e. instructions for the prescription, how often to take medication and what dose) and it will show in the medications grid.</p>
MM-2645	<p>Need to have a page break when printing records. More compact layout (-> reduced paper consumption) and fewer page flow issues (page break in table after header row, etc.).</p>
MM-2699	<p>Diagnosis- Show by added order not by Alpha order. Diagnoses are now listed in the sequence they were entered, both in the dashboard and in forms, rather than in alphabetical order.</p>
